



Creative Arts Scholarship (Art) and Creative Arts Scholarship (Design Technology) Expectations at Year Six

Evidence

The Creative Arts Scholarships will be awarded with either an Art or Design Technology endorsement. Candidates should apply for the area in which they feel they have the strongest skills.

All interested candidates, both internal and external applicants, will be asked to bring a selection of recent Art or Design Technology work on Scholarship Day. Photographs of work are acceptable should the work be too large to transport.

Art Applicants should demonstrate:

- a natural and genuine enthusiasm for the subject;
- a high standard of observational drawing;
- Knowledge of the work of a range of artists;
- a willingness and ability to experiment with mediums and processes;

Design Technology Applicants should demonstrate:

- a natural and genuine enthusiasm for the subject;
- a high standard of technical drawing - especially 3D drawing skills;
- An awareness of iconic designers and their designs, these could be from either engineering, fashion design, furniture design, product design or graphic design;
- An ability to design to meet a brief;
- An understanding of the design, prototyping and evaluation process.

Interview

All candidates will be asked to complete a short practical task to ascertain their abilities. Art applicants will be asked to do a short drawing and making task, Design Technology students will be asked to complete a product analysis exercise.

All candidates will have a short interview, during which we will endeavour to ascertain candidates':

- enjoyment of, interest in and enthusiasm for Art and Design or Design Technology;
- previous in-school experience;
- previous outside-school experience;
- potential for future involvement in Art or Design Technology at Terra Nova;
- potential for future involvement in Art or Design Technology at secondary school level.
- Knowledge and wider interest in Art or Design Technology.

Expectations of successful Scholars

Successful candidates would be expected to attend the weekly clubs offered by either Art or Design Technology as appropriate. They should be willing to maintain their interest in the subject and produce work of a high standard. They should also be actively involved in the department.
